GRAHAM FORD PRESIDENT OF THE INTERNATIONAL LIFE SAVING FEDERATION

On behalf of the International Lifesaving Federation (ILS) I am pleased to welcome participants from all around the world to the Lifesaving World Championships 2022 (LWC2022) in the beautiful Italian city of Riccione.

It is now almost 4 years since we last held LWC 2018 in Adelaide, Australia, and the intervening years have seen many events affected by the Covid-19 pandemic. We cannot forget that Italy itself became a focal point in the initial weeks as the virus continued to spread far and wide. When the ILS took the unenviable decision to postpone LWC 2020 to 2022, many thought this was the wrong decision.

However, the last two years has shown just how sensible that decision was as we could not have held it in 2021. Even then, because of the logistical impacts of managing through the Covid-19 pandemic, we reluctantly had to cancel all the Interclub events except the Masters, that precedes the National Teams events.

Now, here we are in September 2022 with a record attendance of 55 National Teams in the National Teams Championships. The commitment of the Italian Federation, FIN, in financially supporting attendees from the Developing Nations of the ILS to enable them to attend, many for the first time, is a very generous and substantial amount, for which we are very grateful.

We will also see almost 550 Masters participating in their events in the week leading up to the National Team Championships, which is very pleasing to see, particularly in the light of the challenges faced by participants because of Covid-19.

We are also very grateful to FIN for hosting an additional International Event alongside the Masters Lifesaving World Championships to provide some opportunities for those aged 15 to 29 whose Interclub events were unfortunately cancelled. The FIN Rescue World Cup will see more than 360 younger competitors from almost 90 clubs participating.

Finally, I want to recognize the extraordinary effort that FIN has put into organizing and delivering the LWC 2022 events. So many difficult challenges have been put before them but they have not held back in putting on an excellent Lifesaving World Championships.

Riccione 2022: Fifty-five countries representing all continents; lifesaving begins with the first world championship of the post covid19 era, setting a record of participating nations. A matter of pride for the Italian Swimming Federation's Lifesaving Section, but above all a great motivation for the world of lifesaving, which, with renewed energy, projects its own consolidated image on the international sporting scene.

It is now a consolidated heritage of world culture that sport is able to generate values that can be transferred to everyday life; let us recall together, for a moment, the most obvious ones:




